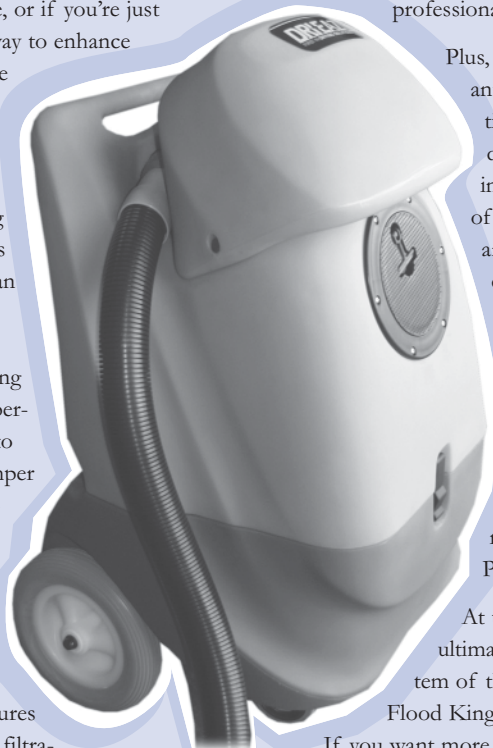
To save you time, it features an advanced three-stage filtration system that results in less clogging. The filters are also longer-lasting, reducing the

## DriTec Pro 150 ducting now available

For your convenience, Dri-Eaz now offers ducting for the DriTec Pro 150 desiccant dehumidifier's moist-air outlet. This new ducting kit includes two-inch ducting that is 13 feet long plus a two-inch hose clamp. The ducting is lightweight, flexible and listed as a UL 94 V-O flame retardant. Most importantly, it has a heat rating of 325° F (162.8° C) which is the rating required for the DriTec Pro 150.

**Important:** The two-inch outlet on the DriTec Pro 150 **must** be ducted in order to operate properly.

The four-inch dry air outlet may or may not be ducted using standard ducting; use no ducting for standard operating capacity. If four-inch ducting is used, the manual advises to use no more than 13 feet when operating on low and no more than 32 feet on high.
